As a **Concrete Quality Technician**, you will be responsible for:

- Carrying out routine fresh concrete tests, including slump, air content, temperature, and density.
- Preparing and curing concrete cube samples for compressive strength testing.
- Performing laboratory and site testing in accordance with BS EN standards and company procedures.
- Recording and reporting all test results accurately and maintaining testing logs.
- Supporting batching plant teams to ensure correct mix designs are used.
- Assisting with troubleshooting when concrete performance issues arise.
- Liaising with plant operators and drivers to ensure product consistency.
- Maintaining laboratory equipment and ensuring calibration of testing instruments.
- Assisting with the development and modification of concrete mix designs.
- Monitoring raw materials (cement, aggregates, admixtures) for compliance with specifications.
- Ensuring all testing and processes comply with industry standards and health & safety regulations.
- Maintaining documentation for ISO quality systems where applicable.

- Knowledge of concrete technology and testing methods.
- Familiarity with BS EN concrete standards.
- Good data recording and reporting skills.
- Full UK driving licence (often required for site visits).
- Experience with batching plants or construction materials (preferred).
